

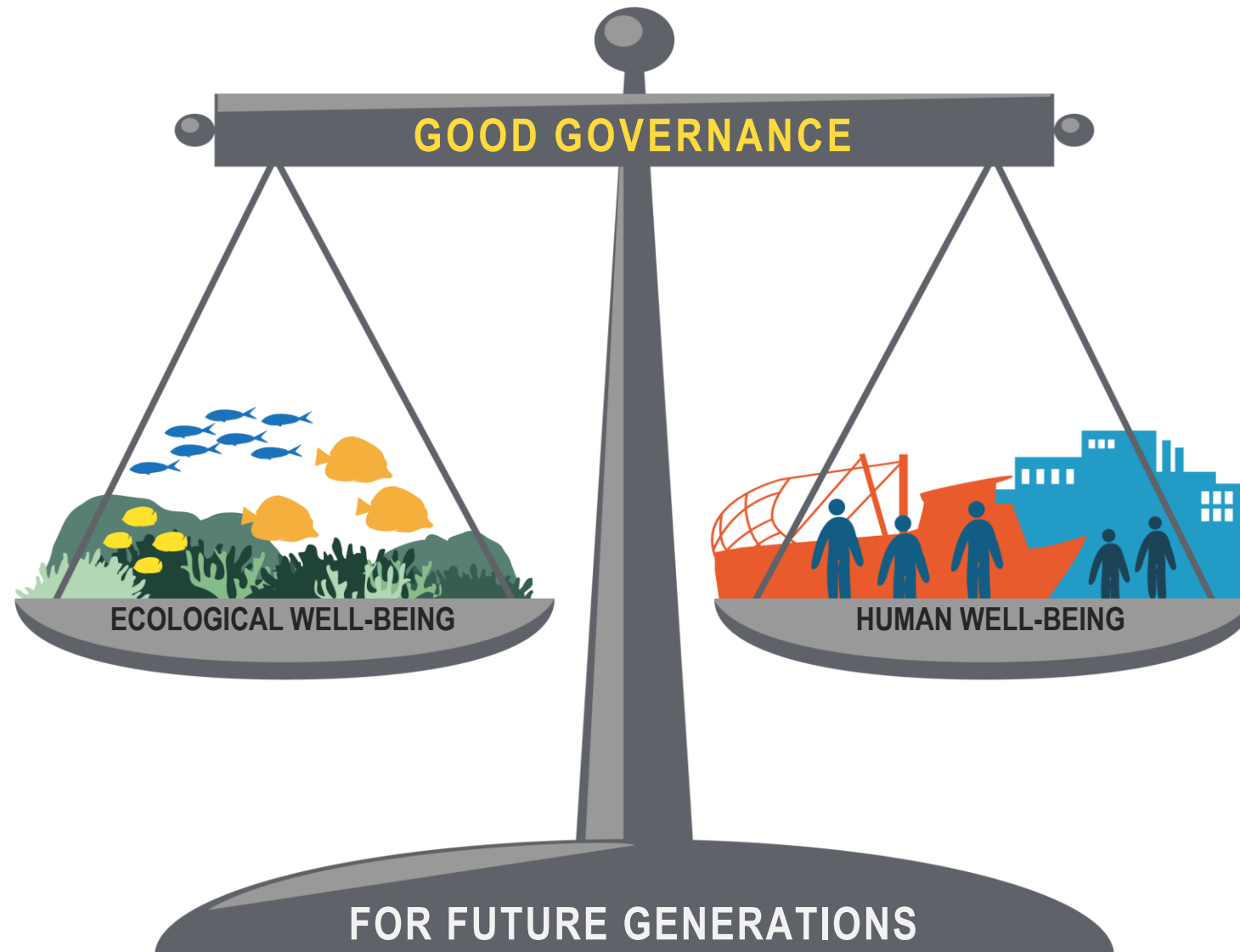

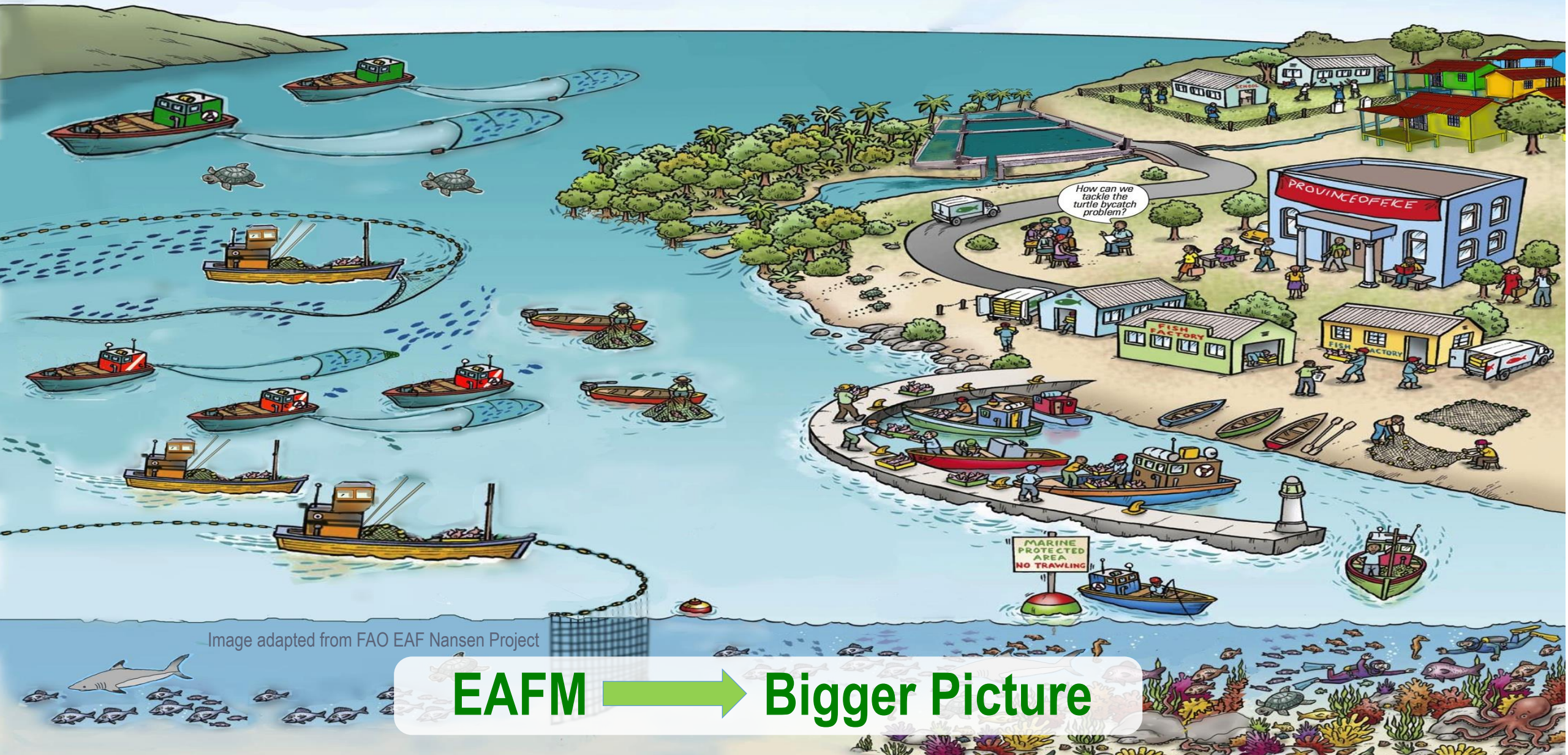

7. Precautionary approach

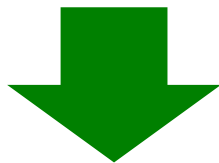

*Sustainably manage fisheries*

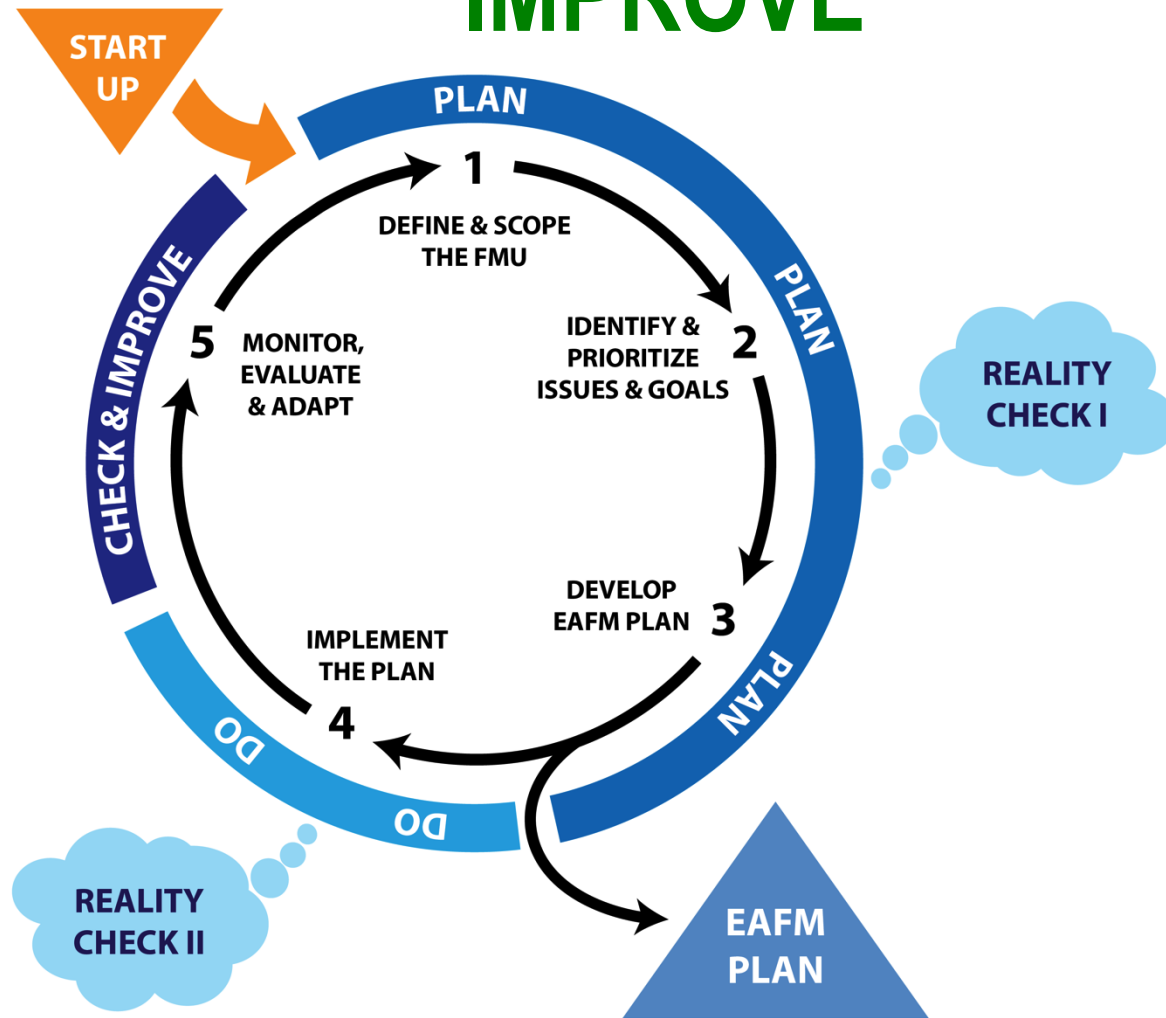
*Limit fishing effort in the trawl fishery*

*Control number of fishing boats/gears*

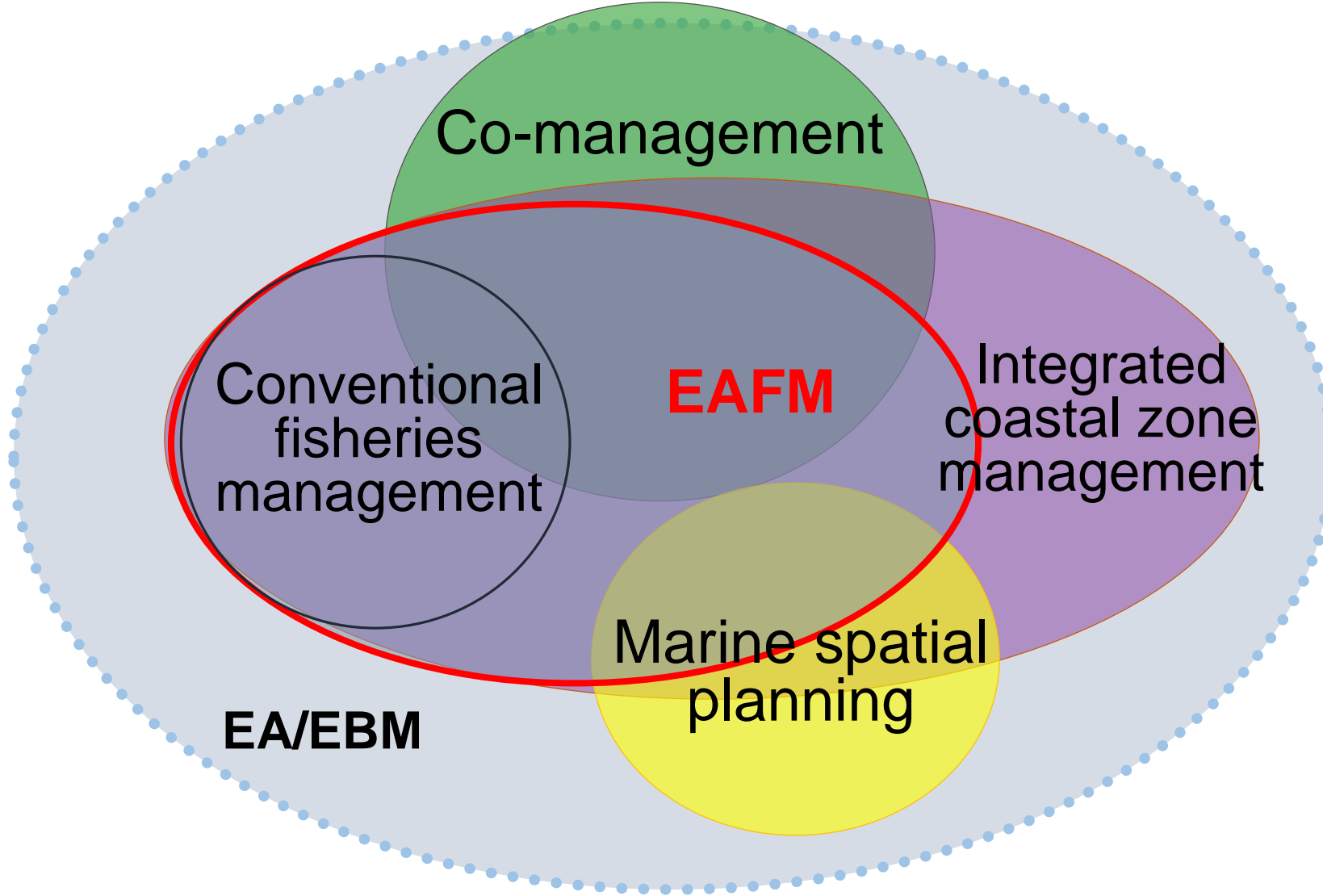


EAFM is based on
